



PRE-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

Have you had all your required and appropriate pre-admission lab work and/or EKG completed?

Note: Lab test results are typically acceptable form 30 days from the original date of the results; EKG result for 6 months from the original date of the results. For any clarification of what test are required and/or acceptable, you should contact your surgeon at least 4 days prior to your scheduled procedure. Be sure to print your name and surgery date on all papers.

Have the lab results been sent to your Surgeon and/or West Parkway?

Have you obtained all the appropriate Referrals from your Primary Care Physician, if needed?

Have you obtained the necessary pre-certification/authorization number from your insurance carrier (where applicable)?

Do you have your insurance cards and photo ID to bring on day of surgery?

Did you leave your valuables and jewelry at home (BRING your insurance cards)?

Did you remember to wear comfortable clothing?

Have your removed all jewelry, including body piercing jewelry?

Have you arranged for a reliable person to give you a ride home?

Do you have a responsible person to stay with you overnight post-operatively?

Did you provide your surgeon and the Surgery Center with 1or 2 phone numbers where you can be reached two-days prior to your procedure?

Did you remember not to eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery (unless otherwise instructed by your physician)?

Did you read the enclosed West Parkway Ambulatory Surgery Patient brochure?
